PROMOTING A DRUG- & ALCOHOL-FREE WORKPLACE

STATS:

- A typical “recreational” drug user is 3 times more likely to injure himself or another person in the work place and 2.2 times more likely to request time off.
- Drug users are 5 times more likely to file a worker’s compensation claim.
- 40% of industrial fatalities and 47% of industrial injuries are related to alcohol abuse and alcoholism.

WORKPOINT WELLNESS CAN ASSIST:

- Urine drug collection
- Breath & blood alcohol testing
- Employee education and awareness training
- Department of Transportation/Federal Compliance Assistance

MEDICAL REVIEW OFFICER (MRO):

- Available upon request to review drug screen results

24-HOUR/7 DAYS-A-WEEK:

- Regular office hours — Monday through Friday, 9am to 3:30pm.
- After hours — Enter through the Emergency entrance. The ER greeter will either call a house supervisor or lab medical technologist to perform the drug and/or alcohol screen as quickly as possible.
