

Industrial Rehabilitation

ASSURE PROPER TREATMENT, REHABILITATION AND REDUCE CHANGE OF REINJURY

STATS:

Once an injury takes place with an employee:

- After 6 months of not working — less than 50% chance to return to work
- After one year of not working — less than 10% change to return to work
- More than one year of not working — “Negligible” chance to return to work

SERVICES:

- **ERGONOMICS ASSESSMENT/CONSULTATION:** an evaluation of the biomechanics of the work environment that includes recommendations for engineering and/or administration modifications to the workplace.
- **FUNCTIONAL CAPACITY EVALUATIONS (FCE):** an assessment of an employee’s abilities (strength, flexibility, endurance and body mechanics) to meet job requirements, along with return-to-work recommendations
- **JOB SITE FUNCTIONAL ANALYSIS (JSA):** an assessment of the worker, the work, and the work site to identify and quantify the physical components and demands of a job.
- **ONE-ON-ONE EDUCATION ON PREVENTION OF RE-INJURY**
- **POST OFFER EMPLOYMENT TESTING (POET):** physical screen performed post-offer, but pre-hire, to determine whether an applicant can safely perform the essential functions of a specific job
- **WORK READINESS PROGRAM (WRP): WORK CONDITIONING/WORK HARDENING** structured, goal-oriented, individualized treatment program designed to return a person to work quickly
